Football Strips – Karyn wondered whether there would be any possibility of getting new strips as the old ones are getting quite worn. Bark replacement – Kevin made the PC aware that there may be a possibility that the bark would need to be fully replaced after few years with a rubber granule. The cost of maintenance is covered by Orkney Builders for a 10 year period so this would not have a financial effect until then – although OB's have said that they would remove and replace the bark with the granules within the 10 year span – meaning an outlay for the granules

<u>Hydration in Schools</u> – Karyn brought to our attention that there is going to be a huge push towards children drinking more water in school time – studies have shown huge benefits in keeping hydrated ie better concentration spans meaning that learning becomes easier, better bladder control in younger children, fewer headaches and dental problems.

Water bottles available on tables and teacher intervention was also discussed, it is hoped that with the information board showing the massive amounts of sugar in energy drinks etc at the Parents Evening, and Karyn possibly attending a Business Meeting at the school that the point will get across
