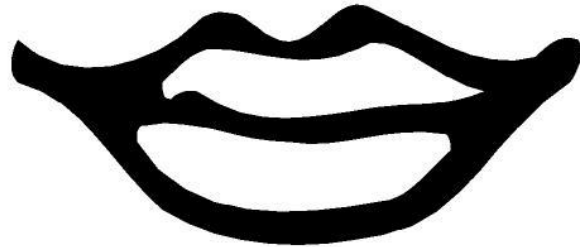

# The Five Senses



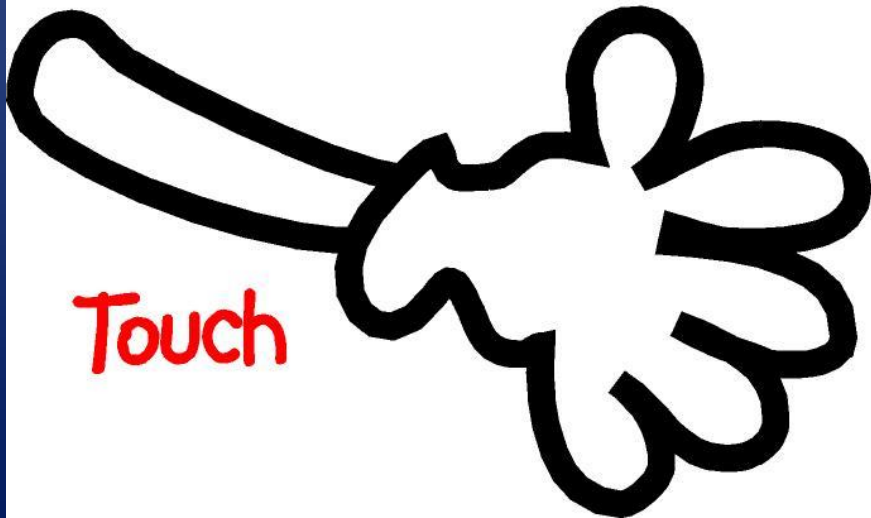
Smell



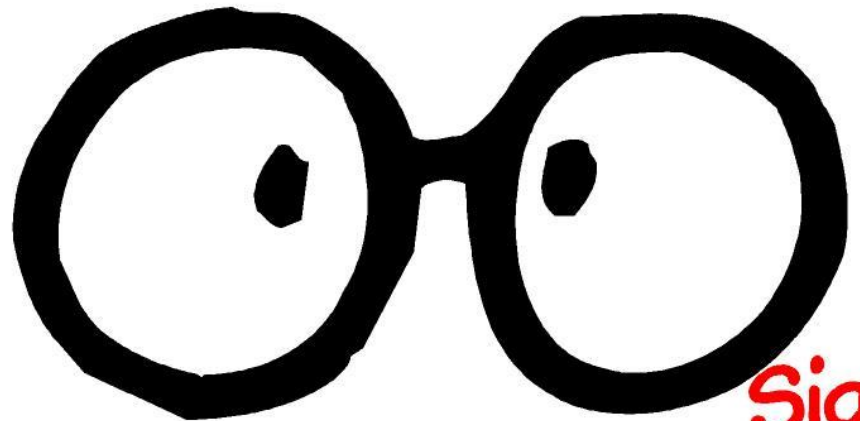
Taste

Learning to say  
tables while  
seeing it written  
down uses  
SIGHT and  
SOUND - More  
than one SENSE  
at SAME time.

$$4 \times 1 = 4$$

$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

$$4 \times 3 = 8$$

$$4 \times 4 = 16$$

$$4 \times 5 = 20$$

$$4 \times 6 = 24$$

$$4 \times 7 = 28$$

$$4 \times 8 = 32$$

$$4 \times 9 = 36$$

$$4 \times 10 = 40$$





When we  
SEE the  
words and  
HEAR the  
words at  
same time  
we learn  
better.

Copying words  
with magnetic  
letters uses  
**MORE** than  
one **SENSE** at  
a time.  
(sight and  
touch)
