#### Office Hours/Reporting Absences

It's all change in the school office as Mrs Mackay steps in to fill the shoes of the amazing Mrs Tait who will be away on maternity leave from 19<sup>th</sup> August. We have also tweaked our office opening times as follows:

Mondays & Tuesdays: 8.30am – 4pm Wednesdays: 8.30am – 3.30pm Thursdays & Fridays: 8.30am – 3.45pm

We are also introducing a new answering system in the school office. For reporting pupil absences, you can now call the school at any time (even the night before, middle of the night, whenever you fancy!). Just select Option 1 and leave a message with your child's name, class, the day and the reason they are absent. We will then check these messages at 9.30am the next day before doing our registers. If you are phoning after 9.30am with an absence you would need to select Option 2 to be put through to the office staff to ensure we receive the message re your child's absence.

We hope you'll be patient with us as we manage our way through these changes.

#### P6 Outdoor Education

Each participating child has been allocated to one of nine groups and families should have received this information by letter. If you've not received your information, then please let us know as soon as you can, as the first three groups begin their activities on August 19<sup>th</sup>. Please remember that Outdoor Education instructors will not permit pupils to join the planned activities unless we can show that we have received a completed Participant Visit Consent (E1) from you, so please return the forms asap.

#### Communication Platforms

The school uses the following communication channels; Microsoft Teams, Seesaw, Groupcall/Xpressions, Email, Texts and Facebook. Our <u>website</u> has more information, but here is quick overview of the purpose of each channel.

**Microsoft Teams**: this will be used for communication from Class Teachers as, for example, they may put homework assignments on here.

**Seesaw**: this was voted the favourite channel by parents and carers this year and is a place where you can see what the children have been up to in class. We also post non-urgent general school announcements here as well.

Please note if your class has two teachers and you wish to message them via seesaw, please ensure you add **both** teachers to your message so that your message is not missed.

**Groupcall/Xpressions, Email and Texts**: This is the main way we communicate more urgent or pupil/class specific information from our school office.

**Facebook**: General info and news will be posted here. There may be some overlap with Seesaw.
