Primary School Football

Teams have now been selected by the coaches for the Primary School Football League this year and pupils have been informed whether they have been selected. Training continues to take place at KGS on Thursday evenings for those selected for the teams. The cost per session remains £1.50. This payment contributes to the cost of team registration (£100 per team) and hire of KGS.

Full fixture dates to be confirmed but the first day will be Saturday the 12th November, with approximately five weeks of fixtures before Christmas and another five after Christmas. We've been informed by the League that, as per last year, fixtures will be held at Picky between 4-8pm generally with a mini-league format which will mean teams will play a number of fixtures for approximately one hour each time.

Primary School Netball (P6/P7)

Teams have now been selected by the coaches for the Primary School Netball League this year and pupils have been informed whether they have been selected. Training continues to take place after school on Wednesdays in our Infant Hall for those selected for the teams. The cost per session remains 50p. This payment contributes to the cost of team registration.

We are also running a 'fun' netball session after school on Mondays in the Infant Hall for those P6/P7 pupils who missed out on a squad place but still wish to practice and play some friendly games. This will be free of charge as there are no registration or hire costs.

Primary School Netball (P5)

We will be holding two free-to-attend P5 netball team selection events on the Infant Hall (315 - 415pm) on Thursday 27 October and Thursday 3 November. Details on future training sessions and costs of participating will be shared with those pupils selected after these sessions.

Halloween and a Road Safety Reminder

We are asking that pupils do not wear Halloween costumes to school on Monday 31^{st} October but, in recognition of the date, our Junior Road Safety Officers are running a colouring-in competition to raise awareness of the need to be bright and be seen this Halloween. They also ask that parents and carers are extra considerate in the darker months and absolutely stick to parking and striding from the KGS carpark. Papdale Halls of Residence have also requested that, for safety reasons, parents and carers do not use PHoR as a dropping off point.

Papdale Participation Fund

We are pleased to announce that an anonymous donation, which was matched by charitable and gift-aid contributions, has resulted in the establishment of a joint School/Parent Council Papdale Participation Fund which currently sits at almost £3K. This fund will help us to ensure that no pupils miss out on experiences due to financial hardship.

Sensory Room

Despite the incredible investment in books, we are still yet to completely spend the funding raised by the Parent Council with the Miles in May initiative. I am pleased to report that we've now identified and refurbished a space for the promised and long-awaited Sensory Room, and we hope to have this fully equipped and ready to launch by the end of this calendar year. Thanks for your generous help in making these amazing developments possible.

Scholastic Bookfair

I'm also pleased to report that your investment in purchasing books at the recent Scholastic Book Fair, held around Parents' Evening, combined with the credits we received from Miles in May book purchases, leaves the school with a Scholastic balance of just over £500 to spend on more new books for the school. This, combined with the very popular Book Neuk, must place us as one of the most pro-active, literacy-focused schools in the land.

Rights Respecting Schools Award

Papdale Primary have registered for this award which looks at UNCRC - UNICEF UK (United Nation's Convention on the Rights of the Child). The Papdale Voices will begin to lead activities towards our Bronze Award this term by kicking off with an introductory assembly for the whole school on Monday 31st October. Watch this space as we will be sharing more information with parents/carers soon. The Papdale Voices will also lead Anti-Bullying Week 2022 - Listen Up! (Respect our Rights) 14-18 November 2022.
