Connect policies - Need to be done. Some can be duplicated from existing school policies for continuity

- **Pool** - Andy has sent further emails but still no progress
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- **Junior high** - summarised response from Peter Diamond. acknowledged budget challenges and expressed interest in exploring flexi-schooling or a North Walls-supported virtual school. However, due to limited resources, a full offer by August 2025 will not happen. Current plans for transition to Stromness or Kirkwall schools should continue, though future discussions are welcome.
- Janine responded 21st March to request the next steps but it yet to receive a reply.
- There is E-SGOUL initially used by Western Isles for a teacher shortage The program has developed into a nationwide community for online teaching and learning. A possibility for students wishing to stay on Island. To be explored further.
- **Outside area** - response from Liam McArthur inc. correspondence from James Wylie, Corporate Director, Education, Leisure and Housing, OIC.

In Summery -

Mr. Wylie acknowledges major budget pressures, including a £3.4 million savings target and £100 million in maintenance needs over 10 years. Despite limited funding, Orkney has received modest government allocations for play park renewal, supplemented by £400k from the council. North Walls Centre was awarded £25k for improvements to its games area. “OIC is, therefore, providing both officer and financial support to the improvements at North Walls School”. While the council supports these upgrades, ongoing maintenance remains a community responsibility. Inspectors found no welfare concerns at North Walls School. Mr. Wylie proposes a meeting to discuss financial constraints, and the writer invites further comments.

- A frustrating response with no clear path for the playground areas. Rachael sends regular reports on the state of the playground with no response from OIC. OIC noted the state of

the Nursery tiled floor on their visit and said they would replace this. However, after further emails from Andy, the council do not appear to have an interest in carrying this out.

- There is £2324.14 raised in 2022 from the Blue Door sale that is available to assist in repairs for the nursery area.
- Email needs to be sent to OIC with a clear plan to move forward. If they will not maintain can we and who does liability fall with?
- **Multi use games area (MUGA) NWCS.**
- Two very different quotes for all weather surface. 80/60k
- 25k funding (5% match grant) accepted from council.
- Applied for £40K from Sports Scotland
- Applied for £10K from CLLD (Community Led Local development).
- **Fruit.** Emails to be sent to parents to see if they would like students in class 2 to still have their fruit snack now funding has ceased.
- Fruit/veg can be sourced through Scott Pring - catering manager
- PC will need to fund.
- Involve the children in the fruit and veg choice.
